HaKoach: *The All-Jewish Soccer Team that Conquered Austria*

Founded by Austrian Zionists in 1909 HaKoach was an all-Jewish soccer team committed to bringing together the best Jewish athletes from throughout Europe. The club was successful for many years until it was shut down by the Nazis as they rose to power in the late 1930s. In addition to learning about HaKoach's history and success, participants will have the chance to discuss several important questions that



are more global in nature: Should Jewish people automatically support/root for a team, player or coach that that is Jewish? Should we expect Jewish athletes and coaches to be Jewish role models for our children and families? Should we expect those same players and coaches to have a strong connection to Israel? What if Jewish athletes and coaches do not live up to the Jewish community's expectations?



Lunch & Learn programs are offered on the third Thursday of each month. Each program is a self-contained course of study from 12:15 to 1:30 pm. A cold buffet lunch is available, starting at 11:45 am.
