Inside this wonderful garden on the Shir Ami grounds is the expansion of the winding brick pathway to include personal dedication markers along its course. Congregants should consider the **Pathway of Life** as a personal and permanent way to celebrate *simchas*, memorialize loved ones, and honor the special people in our lives.

The best way to be a part of this dedication pathway is with an engraved brick or paver. The brick measures 4" x 8" and contains up to 3 lines (limited to 15 characters per). Also interspersed throughout the pathway will be some larger 8" x 8" paver blocks. These featured pieces allow up to 4 engraved lines. Each dedication will be randomly inset into the pattern of the walkway. The initial dedication of the Biblical Garden Pathway will take place in early Autumn 2011.
